- 1. "foreknown" means it was not an accident that Christ was the price of redemption.
 - a. Christ was chosen in advance.
- 2. God's model of "plan-it-then-do-it" is seen in:
 - a. Isaiah 37:26 -

"Have you not heard that I determined it long ago? I planned from days of old what now I bring to pass, that you should make fortified cities crash into heaps of ruins,..."

- b. Romans 8:28-29 -
 - "And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good,[h] for those who are called according to his purpose. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the firstborn among many brothers."
- 3. The New Testament identifies that God was working his plan through the ages until that hidden plan was revealed in Christ and his life:
 - a. Rom. 16:25-26 -
 - "Now to him who is able to strengthen you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery that was kept secret for long ages but has now been disclosed and through the prophetic writings has been made known to all nations, according to the command of the eternal God, to bring about the obedience of faith."
 - b. 1 Cor. 2:6-10 -
 - "Yet among the mature we do impart wisdom, although it is not a wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are doomed to pass away. But we impart a secret and hidden wisdom of God, which God decreed before the ages for our glory. None of the rulers of this age understood this, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. But, as it is written,

"What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man imagined, what God has prepared for those who love him"—

these things God has revealed to us through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God."

c. Titus 1:1-3 -

"Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the sake of the faith of God's

elect and their <u>knowledge of the truth</u>, which accords with <u>godliness</u>, <u>in hope</u> of eternal life, which God, who never lies, <u>promised before the ages began</u> and at the <u>proper time</u> <u>manifested in his word</u> through the preaching with which I have been entrusted by the command of God our Savior."

- 4. "Revealed" indicates Christ was preexisted as is also spoken of in:
 - a. First Timothy 3:16 -

"Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness:

He was manifested in the flesh,

vindicated by the Spirit,

seen by angels,

proclaimed among the nations,

believed on in the world.

taken up in glory."

b. Heb. 9:25-26 -

"Nor was it to offer himself repeatedly, as the high priest enters the holy places every year with blood not his own, for then he would have had to suffer repeatedly since the foundation of the world. But as it is, he has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself."

c. 1 John 1:1-3 -

"That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we looked upon and have touched with our hands, concerning the word of life— the life was made manifest, and we have seen it, and testify to it and proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and was made manifest to us— that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ."

d. 1 John 3:5 -

"You know that he appeared in order to take away sins, and in him there is no sin."

- 5. The New Testament also indicates that this "revealing" began the final age or the last days.
- 6. These <u>final days</u> or this <u>final age</u> will end when the resurrected Jesus is <u>revealed a second</u> <u>time:</u>
 - a. Acts 2:16-21 -

"But this is what was uttered through the prophet Joel:

'And in the last days it shall be, God declares,

that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh,

and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, ...

....And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

b. Colossians 3:3-4 -

"For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory."

c. 1 Peter 5:4

"And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory."

- d. 1 Cor. 10:11 -
 - "Now these things happened to them as an example, but they were written down for our instruction, on whom the end of the ages has come."
- e. 1 John 3:2-3 -

"Beloved, we are God's children now, and what we will be <u>has not yet appeared</u>; but we know that <u>when he appears</u> we shall be like him, because we shall see him as he is.

And everyone who thus hopes in him purifies himself as he is pure."

7. Others had waited in the Old Testament for this age, but we the church now see it and benefit from it

- 1. We and the Christians Peter was writing to experience a privileged position since we are now in Christ and waiting for his 2nd revealing.
- 2. Through Jesus' 1st revealing we believe/trust in God because he raised Jesus from the dead.
- 3. So, now, Peter's readers can do more than fear God, they can trust the God they fear and put their hope in him.
- 4. Point of 1:20-21 is:
 - a. Now believers are to live holy lives (1:14-16)
 - b. Now believers are to fear God who is their judge (1:17)
 - c. Because God has redeemed them with Christ's blood (1:18-19)
 - d. Because God has a plan that he has now revealed (1:20).
 - e. So, these believers can trust God through Jesus because of:
 - i. what Jesus said,
 - ii. what Jesus did
 - iii. how God raised Jesus from the dead. (1:21)

- 1. The verbs are in the perfect tense in the Greek which indicate these believers are already in this state of having been purified and having obeyed.
- 2. Obedience to the truth is believing the Gospel.
- 3. "Purified yourselves"
 - a. purification in the Old Testament made the worshipper ready to participate
 - i. Ex. 19:10-11 -
 - "The Lord said to Moses, "Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow, and let them <u>wash their garments</u> and be ready for the third day. For on the third day <u>the Lord will come</u> down on Mount Sinai <u>in the sight of all</u> the people."
 - ii. Josh. 3:5-6 -
 - "Then Joshua said to the people, "Consecrate yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you." And Joshua said to the priests, "Take up the ark of the covenant and pass on before the people." So they took up the ark of the covenant and went before the people."
 - iii. John 11:55 -
 - "Now <u>the Passover</u> of the Jews was at hand, and many went up from the country to Jerusalem before the Passover <u>to purify themselves</u>."
 - iv. Acts 21:23-26 -
 - "Do therefore what we tell you. We have four men who are <u>under a vow</u>; take these men and <u>purify yourself along with them</u> and pay their expenses, so that they may shave their heads. Thus all will know that there is nothing in what they have been told about you, but that you yourself also live in observance of the law. But as for the Gentiles who have believed, we have sent a letter with our judgment that they should abstain from what has been sacrificed to idols, and from blood, and from what has been strangled, and from sexual immorality." Then Paul took the men, and the next day <u>he purified himself along with them</u> and went into the temple, giving notice when the days of purification would be fulfilled and the offering presented for each one of them."
 - v. Acts 24:18-19 -
 - "While I was doing this, they found me purified in the temple, without any crowd or tumult. But some Jews from Asia— they ought to be here before you and to make an accusation, should they have anything against me..." (Before Felix)

- 4. This purification came through obedience to the truth which is the Gospel invitation:
 - a. 2 Thessalonians 1:5-10 -
 - "This is evidence of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are also suffering— since indeed God considers it just to repay with affliction those who afflict you, and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know God and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from[b] the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might, when he comes on that day to be glorified in his saints, and to be marveled at among all who have believed, because our testimony to you was believed."
- 5. This purification was the born-again experience (phase one), but is practiced and developed in life (sanctification process or phase two)
 - a. James 4:8 -
 - "Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded."
 - b. 1 John 3:3 -
 - "And everyone who thus hopes in him purifies himself as he is pure."
 - c. Galatians 5:7-9 -
 - "You were running well. Who hindered you from obeying the truth? This persuasion is not from him who calls you. A little leaven leavens the whole lump." (legalism, Law, circumcision)
- 6. "by obeying the truth" means positively responding to the Gospel. "
 - a. "Obedience" (hypakoe) 15x in the NT and not clear it is saving faith
 - b. Peter uses "obedience" (hypakoe) in 1:2 and 1:14 to refer to believer's conduct
 - c. "Purify" (hagnizo) is used figuratively to refer to moral purification after salvation
 - d. Context HERE is obedience after salvation
 - The readers are doing the purification which sounds more like <u>phase two</u> than phase one.
