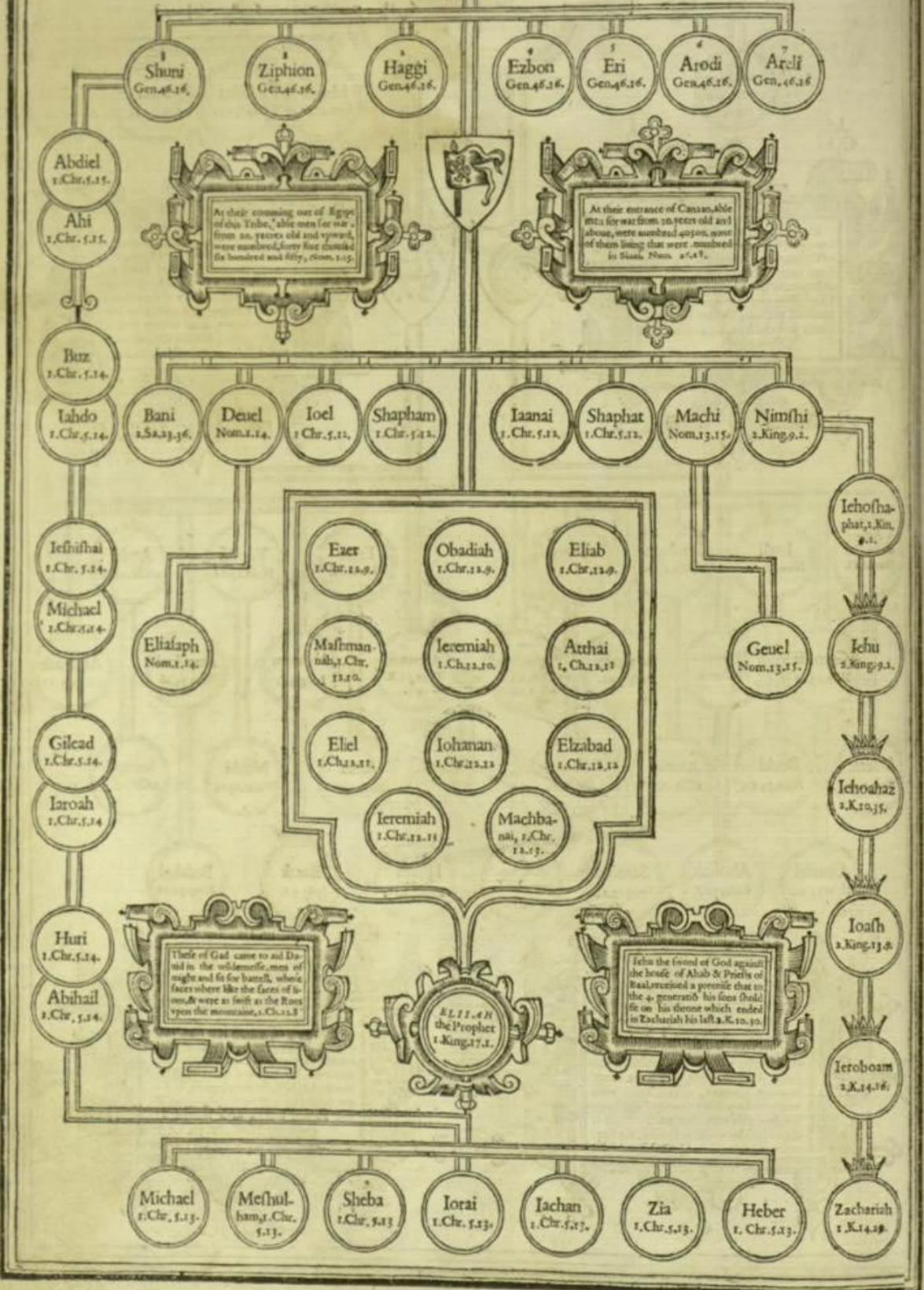


The Evangelists Mathew, and Luke, from David to Mary doe diversly derive the descent of Christ. Saint Mathew bringeth him to be the heire of Davids throne, and by a legall succession from Solomon, and those Kings that possessed the crown, as likewise from those high Saints from whom it was taken, Dan. 7. whereby he was lawfully titled, the King of the Jewes, which his star shewed, and for whom the wisemen sought, that Pilate granted him the confession, and the Jewes to hinder his right could name none but Casar.

Saint Luke sheweth him to be the seed promised in paradise, and by his naturall parents bringeth him from Eli, Pharez, Zorobabel, Neri, Nathan, and David to Adam. For Solomons house ending in Ieconias, 1. Chr. 2. 26. and the Crowne taken from his families, Ezck. 1. 16. the right of his kingdom ascended to his next in kindred according to the Law, Num. 27. and so to Christ, so that these holy Evangelists breathe forth a sweete comfort of his office in person, without all contradiction in their holy records.

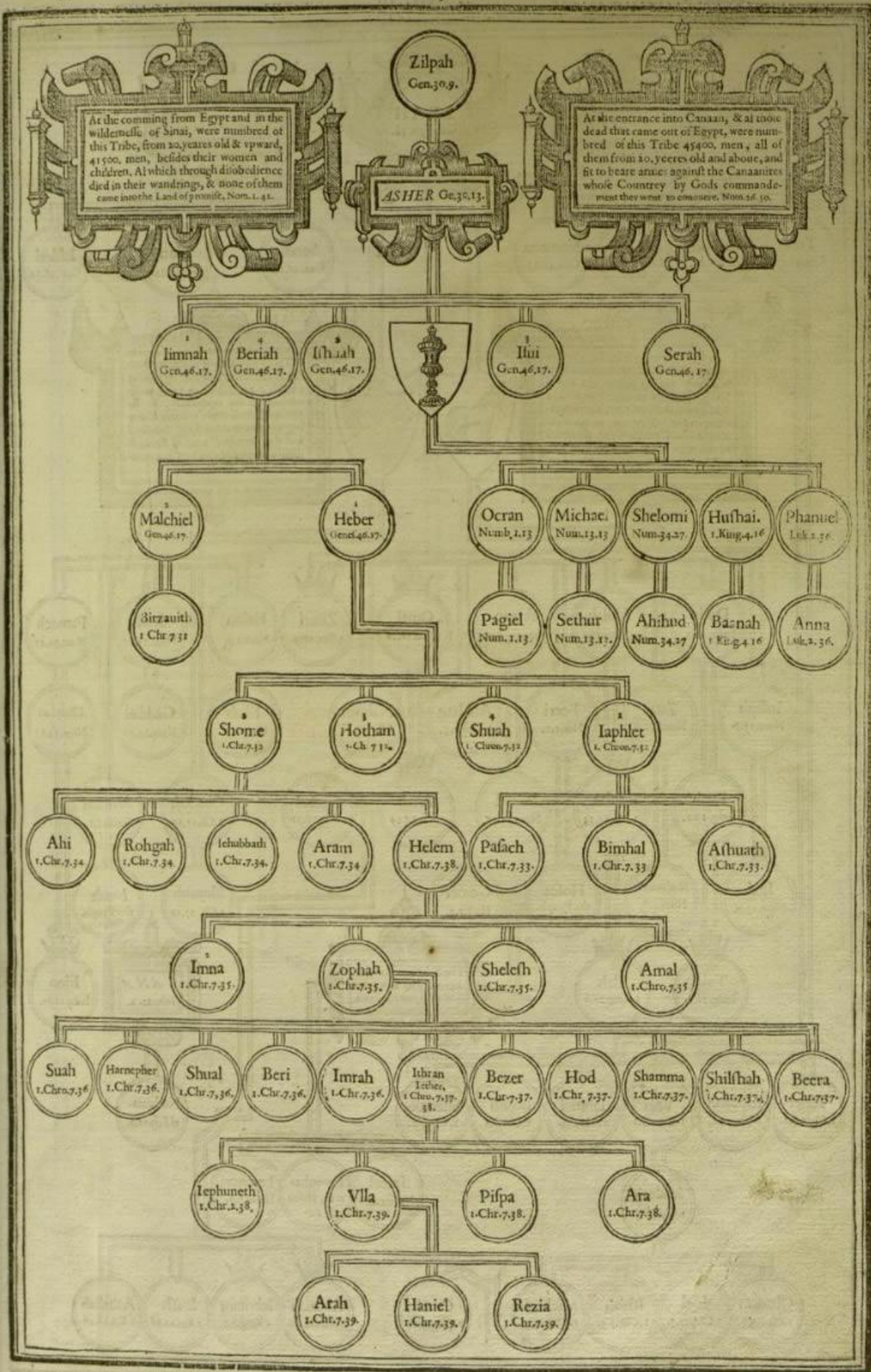
As their entrance of Canaan, able men for war from 20 years old and above, were numbered 40,500, four of them living that were numbered in Sinai, Num. 2.547.

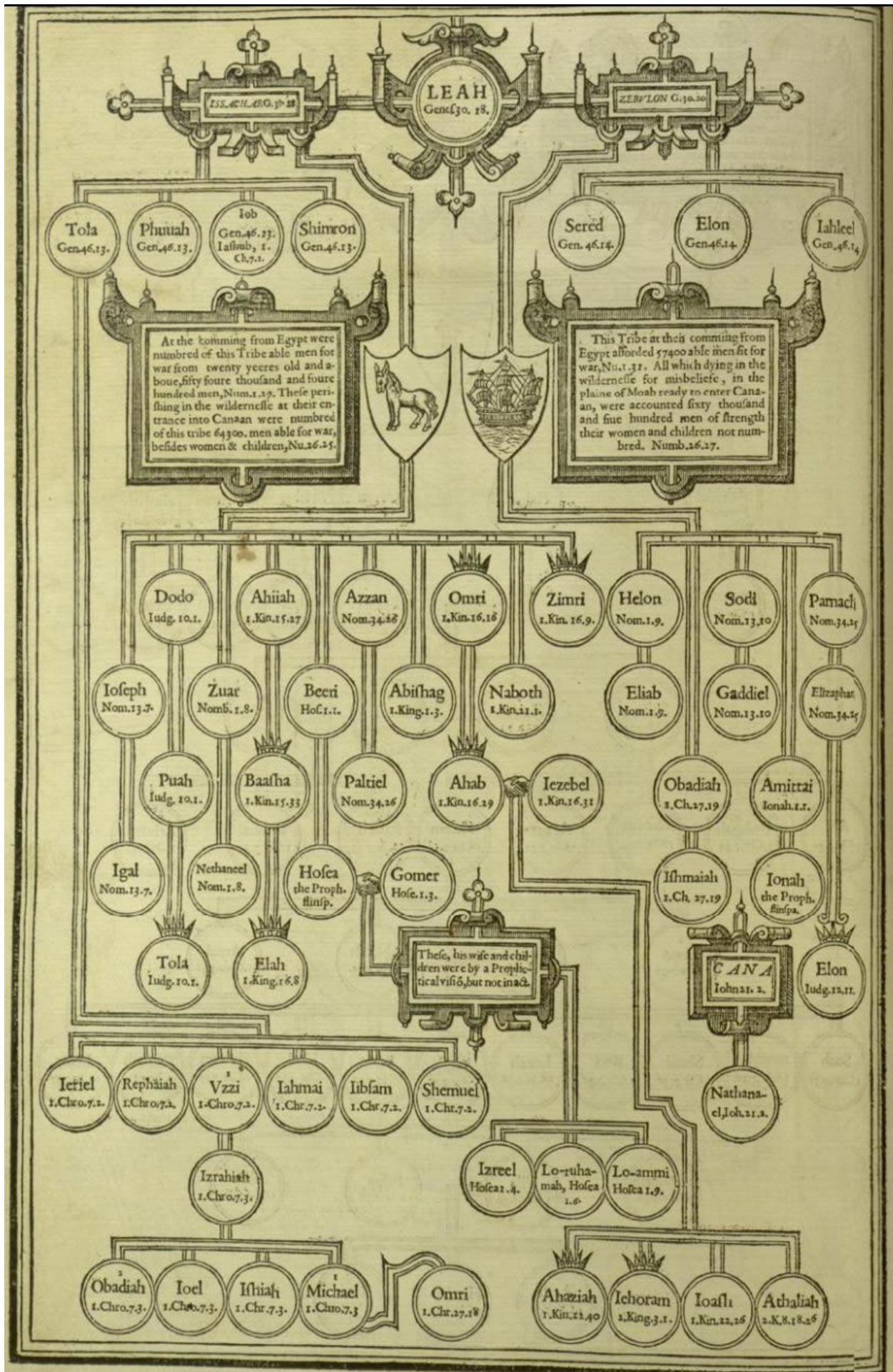

## Genealogy Diagrams from the 1611 King James Bible

The first edition of the King James Bible, published in 1611, featured 34 pages of illustrated genealogy diagrams tracing the lineage from Adam and Eve through the birth of Jesus Christ. Each page includes verse references for every name, explanatory insets, and fanciful icons for the 12 tribes of Israel and other families. The author, John Speed, was a well-known English cartographer who also contributed his map of Canaan to the front pages of the KJV.
