


- 1. This was the year 2578 BC when Noah was 480 years old.
- 2. This was 120 years before the Flood in 2458 BC when Noah was 600 years old.
- 6:4 The Nephilim [b (- ESV "giants")] were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of man and they bore children to them. These were the mighty men who were of old, the men of renown.
- 6:5 The Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intention of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.



6:6 – And the Lord regretted that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him to his heart.



6:7 – So the Lord said, "I will blot out man whom I have created from the face of the land, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens, for I am sorry that I have made them."



6:8 – But Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord.

6:9 – These are the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God.

6:13 – And God said to Noah, "I have determined to make an end of all flesh, for the earth is filled with violence through them. Behold, I will destroy them with the earth.





6:15 – This is how you are to make it: the length of the ark 300 cubits, [450 feet; 150 yards] its breadth 50 cubits [75 feet; 25 yards], and its height 30 cubits [45 feet; 15 yards].



- 1. Volume size was 1.54 million cubic feet (43,500 cubic meters
- 2. The ark would be equal to 522 railroad stock cars.
- 3. One railroad stock car holds 240 sheep; 522 stock cars can hold 125,280 sheep.
- 4. The ark has room for 125,280 sheep, the average size of the animals. This leaves room for 109,280 more average sized animals
 - a. 1.8 million species of organisms
 - b. 98% are fish, invertebrates and non-animals like plants and bacteria
 - c. There are less than 34,000 species today that are land dependent vertebrates
 - d. The ark needed to preserve the ancestors of 34,000 species

6:19 – And of every living thing of all flesh, you shall bring two of every sort into the ark to keep them alive with you. They shall be male and female.



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6:21 – Also take with you every sort of food that is eaten, and store it up. It shall serve as food for you and for them."




Genesis 7:1 – Then the Lord said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and all your household, for I have seen that you are righteous before me in this generation.

- 7:2 Take with you seven pairs of all clean animals, the male and his mate, and a pair of the animals that are not clean, the male and his mate,
- 7:3 and seven pairs of the birds of the heavens also, male and female, to keep their offspring alive on the face of all the earth.
- 7:4 For in seven days I will send rain on the earth forty days and forty nights, and every living thing that I have made I will blot out from the face of the ground."



- 7:5 And Noah did all that the Lord had commanded him.
- 7:6 Noah was six hundred years old when the flood of waters came upon the earth.

- 7:7 And Noah and his sons and his wife and his sons' wives with him went into the ark to escape the waters of the flood.
- 7:8 Of clean animals, and of animals that are not clean, and of birds, and of everything that creeps on the ground,



-Living things are divided into five kingdoms: animal, plant, fungi, protist and monera.

PHYLUM

-Phylum (plural: phyla) is more specific than **kingdom**, but less specific than class.

There are 35 phyla in the kingdom Animalia, including

Chordata (all organisms with a dorsal nerve cord), Porifera (sponges), and Arthropoda (arthropods).

CLASS

- An example of a class would be mammal.

ORDER

- An example of an order would be Carnivora. Dogs are in order Carnivora.

FAMILY

-The **family** of the animals is similar to the **kind** of animals Noah put on the ark.

GENUS

-A **genus** is a group of animals that are very similar and most likely have a common ancestor.

In contrast, a **species** is just one type of animal.

For example, zebras are in the genus called Equus.

This genus includes all horses, donkeys, and zebras.

SPECIES

-Species is a term used in the modern classification system. The Bible uses the term "kind." The created **kind** was a much broader category than the modern term of classification, species.

BREED

-A **breed** is a collection of organisms within a species that have different characteristics as a result of selective breeding. A species is a group of creatures that may breed to generate viable offspring when they interbreed.

- 1. 1.8 million species of organisms
- 2. 98% are fish, invertebrates and non-animals like plants and bacteria
- 3. There are less than 34,000 species today that are land dependent vertebrates
- 4. The arek needed to preserve the ancestors of 34,000 species

KPCOFGS - Kingdom, Phylum, Class, Order, Family Genus, Species

Kingdom – animal - feed on organic matter (not a plant which create energy)

Phylum – vertebrate – a back bone with nerve chord

Class – mammal – milk for offspring, body with hair

Order – primate – opposed thumb, binocular vision

Family – lemuridae – longer nose, smaller brain, long slender limbs, a tail.

Genus - lemur - body shape, vocalizations, scent marking

Species – ring-tailed lemur

Noah did not have to take every "species" on the ark.

Noah could have taken the "genus" on the ark and still preserved the "species" capability.

Even in some cases a "family" representative could have preserved the "genus" and the "species"

There are 8,000 genera (plural of genus) including extinct genera.

That would require 16,000 individual animals on the ark.

Volume size was 1.54 million cubic feet (43,500 cubic meters)

The ark would be equal to 522 railroad stock cars.





- 7:12 And rain fell upon the earth forty days and forty nights.

- 7:15 They went into the ark with Noah, two and two of all flesh in which there was the breath of life.
- 7:16 And those that entered, male and female of all flesh, went in as God had commanded him. And the Lord shut him in.
- 7:17 The <u>flood continued forty days on the earth</u>. The waters increased and bore up the ark, and it rose high above the earth.
- 7:18 The waters prevailed and increased greatly on the earth, and the ark floated on the face of the waters.

- 7:19 And the waters prevailed so mightily on the earth that all the high mountains under the whole heaven were covered.

- 7:21 And all flesh died that moved on the earth, birds, livestock, beasts, all swarming creatures that swarm on the earth, and all mankind.
- 7:22 Everything on the dry land in whose nostrils was the breath of life died.
- 7:23 He blotted out every living thing that was on the face of the ground, man and animals and creeping things and birds of the heavens. They were blotted out from the earth. Only Noah was left, and those who were with him in the ark.
- 7:24 And the waters prevailed on the earth 150 days.
