

- 2. Salt was used to:

#### Colossians 4:7-18

- Paul typically ended his letters greeting people and referring to those who were with him or would be traveling with the letter.
- Here Paul even greets those in nearby towns in the Lycus Valley
- These are not mere idle greetings, but seem to be strategic comments meant to send a message and provide some routine relationship maintenance.
- The closing of Colossians brings 12 people out of their historic past for us to view as contemporaries of this letter and situation its information was addressed to.

- Paul considered these people co-workers along with him.
- Archippus was the pastor left in charge of the church in Colossae (Col. 1:7) when Epaphras left to visit Paul and ask for some assistance concerning the issues in the church in Colossae addressed in this letter.






### **Tychicus**


- Tychicus is from Asia (Acts 20:4), the Western Text narrows it down by saying he is from Ephesus.
- 52 AD or 53 AD Paul first met Tychicus on his second missionary journey when he stopped by Ephesus after leaving Corinth and writing 1 and 2 Thessalonians from Corinth.


### **Aristarchus**


- From Macedonia (Acts 19:29) and called a Macedonian.
- A native of Thessalonica (Acts 20:4 and 27:2)
- A Jew (Col. 4:10)
- Arrested in Ephesian theater (Acts 19:29)
- One of the Macedonians Paul did not want to humiliate the Corinthians (2 Cor. 9:1-5
- One of the delegates taking money to Jerusalem (Ac. 20:4)
- In Jerusalem with Paul and on the prison ship (Acts 27:2). He may have gone onto Rome with Paul or got off and went home (Macedonia) or to Asia before rejoining Paul when he was in prison in Rome.
- Col. 4:10 and Philemon 1:24 is with Paul in first imprisonment.











