
Zechariah 1



Overview of Zechariah

- 1. Zechariah 1-6 Zechariah's Eight Visions on February 15, 519 BC
 - a. Man among the myrtle trees God is watching and controlling history
 - b. Four horns and four horn cutters God will remove the oppressive nations
 - c. Measuring line Jerusalem will have a population explosion
 - d. Garments for the High Priest God is reinstalling the priesthood of Aaron
 - e. **Golden lamp stand and two olive trees** Joshua and Zerubbabel are anointed and are providing the oil for Israel's lamp
 - f. **Flying scroll** There is a curse hanging over the land. Violators of the covenant will be removed from history
 - g. **Woman in a basket** the system of evil will be returned to the pagan land of Babylonia but it will not be part of Israel's new nation.
 - h. **Four chariots** God ultimate victory over the oppressive nations is won and judgment is brought to those nations

2. Zechariah 7-8

- a. Four messages (7:4-8:23) in response to the question about fasting (7:1-3)
 - i. Rebuke
 - ii. Repentance
 - iii. Restoration
 - iv. Rejoicing



 - ii. The rejected King enthroned (12-14)
 - 1. Israel restored and redeemed (12-13)
 - 2. The King returns (14)

529	 Cyrus dies on the battle field verse nomadic barbarians Cyrus was buried in Pasargadae one of the five capital cities (Babylon, Ecbatana, Persepolis, Pasargadae and Susa) Cyrus had built an enormous empire with roads, postal system and legal codes. Cambyses secures the throne by murdering his brother Smerdis 	
525	 Cambyses totally defeats Egypt in the eastern delta of the Nile and captures Memphis. Cambyses desired to capture the Oasis of Ammon further west in the desert and to march on to Carthage but his 50,000 troops perished in the desert and the Phoenician ships refused to land ships carrying Persian soldiers to attack the Phoenician colony of Carthage. 522	Gaumata, a pseudo-Smerdis, claims the throne back in Babylon Cambyses disappears from history near Mt. Carmel on his return to Babylon	
521	 Darius Hystaspes executes Gaumata and takes the throne of the Persian empire Darius Hystaspes searches the royal archives in Babylon and finds that Cyrus had ordered the rebuilding of the temple in Jerusalem. 490	 Darius attacks Athens by sailing across the Agean Sea and land 20 miles from Athens on the plains of Marathon. The Persians had 600 ships with 20,000 men; Athenians had 10,000 men A Greek runner ran 150 miles in 36 hours to Sparta for help but Sparta didn't come Miltiades, an Athenian general, launched an attack by charging down the hill in formation with thin middle ranks. Persia broke through the middle line but found themselves trapped and rushed back to their ships The Persians headed for the bay of Athens but the Athenians out ran them there and Persia returned home. - August 29, 520 Build the Temple
- October 17, 520 Do not be discouraged
- October 27, 520 Zechariah 1:1-6
- December 18, 520 Blessing begins today
- December 18, 520 Zerubbabel is like the Lord's signet ring
- Dated according to the reign of a Gentile King and not an Israelite King or event. This was the "time of the Gentiles" foretold by Daniel and referred to by Jesus (Daniel 2; 7; Luke 21:24)
- 3. Zechariah
 - a. A prophet
- 4. Mentioned in Ezra:
 - a. Ezra 5:1 "Now the prophets, Haggai and <u>Zechariah the son of Iddo</u>, prophesied to the Jews who were in Judah and Jerusalem, in the name of the God of Israel who was over them."
 - b. Ezra 6:14 "And the elders of the Jews built and prospered through the prophesying of Haggai the prophet and <u>Zechariah the son of Iddo</u>. They finished their building by

decree of the God of Israel and by decree of Cyrus and Darius and Artaxerxes king of Persia."

- 5. Father was Berechiah; Grandfather was Iddo (In Hebrew "son" can also mean descendant, such as in Jesus being the "son of David")
 - a. There is an Iddo in Nehemiah 12:4 who was the head of a priestly clan in the second generation of the exiles who returned to Jerusalem
 - b. In Nehemiah 12:16 Zechariah takes the leadership of the same priestly clan.
 - c. Zechariah then would be a priest and a leader among the priest. (Other prophets who were from the priestly family were: Moses, Samuel, Jeremiah, Ezekiel and Zechariah son of Jehoiada.

1:2 – ""The LORD was very angry with your fathers.




- 1. The people of 520 BC were where they are because the Lord was angry with their sinful lives and rebellious culture.
- 2. This understanding as foundational worldview in 520 BC is the absolute necessity. If they do not get this then they are doomed. If they understand and accept this Truth then they can begin the process of advancing in God's plan.
- 3. Note the Hebrew says "has been angry...very" some literally translate this to say "angry with anger"

1:3 – "Therefore say to them, Thus declares the LORD of hosts: Return to me, says the LORD of hosts, and I will return to you, says the LORD of hosts.



1. The forefathers' sins destroyed Israel, Jerusalem and the Temple, but the current generation's sins was holding up the restoration of the Temple, Jerusalem and the nation.

- Haggai focused on the Temple being rebuilt. Zechariah will focus on much more being rebuilt including the city, the culture and the restoration of the nation fulfilling the purpose of the Lord.
- 1:4 "Do not be like your fathers, to whom the former prophets cried out, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, Return from your evil ways and from your evil deeds.' But they did not hear or pay attention to me, declares the LORD.
